



**The first public hearing on the draft
419 Town Center Plan is complete!
You can now view the public survey

On Tuesday night the Planning Commission held a public hearing to incorporate the 419 Town Center Plan into the County's Comprehensive Plan. Four citizens spoke at the hearing. Their comments included a suggestion to make the draft Plan explicitly pet-friendly; a concern by a current tenant of Tanglewood Mall that the Plan should not be implemented too hastily; and two strong statements of support for the draft Plan. The Commission closed the hearing but did not take action on the draft Plan.
