- **Additional Remarks:** The Roanoke County Police Department is investigating the death of the victim which occurred at a private drive located off the 5900 block of Grandin Road Ext. in southwest Roanoke County. The victim was an elderly man who worked as a delivery driver for Fisher Auto Parts. Victim's body was found beside one of the company's orange and yellow small Chevrolet pickup truck delivery vehicles which was burned. The number "5023" was on the front fender and the words "Express Delivery" appeared on the side of the truck bed.

Currently, the Police Department does NOT suspect foul play to be involved in the victim's death. Nonetheless, we are interested in determining where the victim had been and with whom he may have had any contact between 3:00pm - 5:00pm yesterday afternoon. If anyone believes they may have seen or had contact with the victim during that time period, they are asked to contact Detective McPhail at the number above.
