Halloween Night Tweet-Along

On Halloween Night (October 31, 2016) the Roanoke County Police will participate in their second “tweet-along.” This time, the department will be live tweeting along with other law enforcement agencies throughout the Commonwealth. A tweet-along is a virtual ride-along in which citizens can follow along with an officer who is on patrol. The department recognizes the importance of engaging with the community, and this is another way in which we strive to interact with our community. The tweets will inform citizens of the types of situations that patrol officers face throughout their shifts.
