Multi-Vehicle Crash

3600 Block Of Jae Valley Closed

(Roanoke County, VA) – ****Update to Multi-Vehicle Crash****
April 24, 2019 at 0827 hrs. The 3600 block of Jae Valley Rd. is now fully open to traffic. The investigation is still ongoing.

On April 24, 2019, at approximately 0615 hours, the Roanoke County Police Department responded to a multi-vehicle crash involving injuries in the 3600 block of Jae Valley Road in Roanoke County. Upon arrival to the scene, officers determined that the crash was the result of a head-on collision between two vehicles with at least one motorist sustaining serious injury. Both lanes of travel are blocked at this time and it is recommended that motorists find an alternate route to avoid delay in their commute. A subsequent press release will be issued once the road is back open. Officer L. Campbell is investigating the incident.
