The Roanoke County C.O.P.S. Camp is a collaborative effort between the Roanoke County Police Department, Roanoke County Police Foundation and Roanoke County Parks and Recreation. Our main focus is having FUN!!! We emphasize teamwork and safety to give each young participant an experience they will not soon forget. Any rising sixth, seventh, or eighth grader in a Roanoke County School is welcome to apply for a camper's spot.

A total of 60 camper slots are available. The school resource officer for your child's school will review the application to endorse the application. Selection will be based on citizenship, character, trustworthiness, and being in good standing within the school.

Currently registration is open to all Roanoke Valley students that are rising sixth, seventh, or eighth graders. Registration will end on May 17th, 2024. The cost to attend the week long camp is \$200.00.

Proper camp attire is all you are required. We provide excitement, fun, and new friends. Each camper will be mentored by a Roanoke County Police Officer through the many activities at Camp Roanoke. Each camper will be responsible for bringing their own lunch daily except on July 12th when we will have an end of camp cookout. Contact your school resource officer for further information.

Additional information and complete enrollment forms will be mailed by Camp Roanoke to the home address and email listed on the registration in June.

This is a day camp where the campers have to be dropped off and picked up each day of the camp. Campers can be dropped off at Camp Roanoke between 7:30 am - 9:00 am, and MUST be picked up 4:00 pm. Camp Roanoke will also provide transportation via bus from Tanglewood Mall. Morning drop off at the bus stop will be 8:00 am – 8:20 each morning. Pickup in the evening at Tanglewood Mall will be 4:40 pm – 5:00 pm.
