The Board of Supervisors met this day, being the fourth Wednesday, and second regular meeting of the month, at the Roanoke County Courthouse in Salem, Virginia. Present: Lee B. Eddy, Chairman; Charles H. Osterhoudt, Vice-chairman, Joseph C. Thomas, A. T. Huddleston and L. Earl Simms. Messrs. John Lampros, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney and Paul B. Matthews, Executive Officer, were also present.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and Supervisor A. T. Huddleston offered prayer. The pledge of allegiance was given in unison to the flag led by Chairman Lee B. Eddy.

The minutes of the July 10, 1968 meeting were approved as spread, each member having received copies forwarded to him by the Clerk.

Mrs. Betty Rhodenizer, Mr. Clifford Rhodenizer and Mr. Chris Jamison were present and recognized for their work in connection with the Roanoke County Seal. Supervisor Joseph C. Thomas read the following resolution expressing the Board's appreciation for their contributions, and a framed copy will be forwarded to them at a later date:

WHEREAS, the Roanoke County Board of Supervisors has heretofore commissioned a committee to develop a Seal for the County of Roanoke which committee was composed of public officials of said County; and

WHEREAS, in the carrying out of their commission, the committee did call upon the services of certain private individuals; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the efforts of these individuals, the committee did report and present to the Board of Supervisors a proposed Seal for Roanoke County which was adopted for use by the County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Roanoke County Board of Supervisors to express its appreciation for the services rendered by the private citizens concerned in the development of the Seal heretofore adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Roanoke County Board of Supervisors does hereby express its thanks and appreciation to Clifford Rhodenizer, Betty Rhodenizer and Chris Jamison for the services rendered by them in the development of the Seal for Roanoke County and further, does commend them for their interest and participation in the government of Roanoke County.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be prepared in proper form and presented to the individuals concerned and that the same be signed by the Chairman and attested by the Clerk of the Board.
