The Roanoke County Electoral Board met at 10:00am on Tuesday, March 21, 2017 in order to discuss general business. All members were present as well as the General Registrar and Deputy Registrar. The meeting was called to order at 10:00am.

The first order of business was reorganization of the Electoral Board. Mr. Martin made a motion for the members to continue in the same offices and the vote was unanimous.

It will not affect the June Primary, but a temporary change of locations will be necessary for the November 7, 2017 General Election. The Registrar and Deputy Registrar will research possible locations and present the information to the Board for consideration. There was further discussion regarding polling locations for the upcoming election year as well as ongoing training opportunities for the Registrar and staff through the Department of Election.

The Board discussed training for the Officers of Election for the Dual Primary which has been called for Tuesday, June 13, 2017. There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 12:24pm.
