Ground Breaking Ceremony March 8th

Roanoke County broke ground on the first phase of the Plantation Road Bicycle, Pedestrian and Streetscape Improvement project on March 8th in front of Double Envelope. [Read more](#) about the ceremony and planned improvements.

Construction Activities

Below are several construction activities that have started since mid-March:

- Above-ground utilities continue to be relocated onto new poles;
- Underground utilities are being relocated with sanitary sewer moving first; and
- New storm drain improvements are underway.

Activities taking place next include:

- Installation of a retaining wall between Williamson Road and Indian Road; and
- Work on the drainage ditch between Williamson Road and Hitech Road.

Construction is taking place between 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. with lane closures in place during non-peak hours.
